Prior to Surgery

- Please eat breakfast & take your regular medications.
- Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your appointment.

Mohs Surgery

- **Be prepared to spend up to 6 hours at the clinic.**
- Mohs surgery involves removing the cancer in stages.
- Bring something to do (book, iPad, etc) as we process the tissue (approx 30 min).
- You may choose to bring water and snacks.
- Once the cancer is 100% removed, we will then begin the surgical repair.

After Surgery

- Keep the bulky pressure bandage on for the first 48 - 72 hours following surgery.
- Avoid any strenuous physical activity for the first 72 hours
- Limit use of the site until the sutures are removed.
- Do not soak in water (bath, swimming pool, etc).
- Gently clean site daily without soaking.
- Apply topical ointment (Aquaphor, Vaseline, etc) & keep bandaged.
- We recommend NeoCUTIS BioSerum for scar reduction & healing.
- For pain, take Tylenol (acetaminophen) -- not ibuprofen (Advil or Motrin) or naproxen (Aleve).
